The Harvard House BCI Worldwide Flexible Fund is a worldwide flexible portfolio that aims to deliver a moderate to high long term total return.

### **INVESTMENT POLICY**


In order to achieve its objective, the investments normally to be included in the portfolio may comprise a combination of assets in liquid form, money market instruments, interest bearing securities, bonds, debentures, corporate debt, equity securities, property securities, preference shares, convertible equities and non-equity securities. The portfolio may invest in listed and unlisted financial instruments, participatory interests or any other form of participation in portfolios of collective investment schemes registered in South Africa and other similar schemes, in accordance with the provisions of the Act.


## **INVESTMENT STRATEGY**

The portfolio strategy aims to deliver distribution growth and a total return in the range of Inflation + 4% to 6% per annum over any 5-year rolling period.

## PERFORMANCE (Net of Fees)




